Defination of terms

- Immigration/ иммиграция,
- The process of coming to live permanently in a country that is not your own
- Border/ граница
- the line that devides two country or arreas
- green card/ зеленая карта
- a document that legally allows sb from another contry to live and work in US
- visa/ виза
- a stamp or mark put in your passport by officials of a foriegn country that gives you permission to enter, pass through or leave their country.
- enter,
- to come or go in to sth
- travel/ путешествия,
- to go from one place to aother, especially over a long distance
- passport/ паспорт,
- an official document that identifies you as a citizen of a particular country and you may have to show when you enter or leave leave a country.
- Assimilate/ ассимилировать,

- to become or allow sb to become a part of a country or community rather than remaining in a separate group
- adapt/ адаптировать,
- to change your behavior in order to deal more successfully in a new situation/adjust
- ethnic/ этнический
- belonging to a nation, race or tribe that shares a cultural tradition
- *Refugee*/ беженец
- A person who flees his or her native land to escape persecution or danger.
- *Push-pull factors* / Двухтактные факторы
- What factors pushed emigrants to leave their homelands? What drew them to America?
 - *Acculturation*/ рост культурного уровня
- Changing or modifying one's culture by adapting to or borrowing from another culture.
 - *Alien*
- A person who is not a citizen of the country where he or she resides. An alien may be in the country legally or illegally.
 - *Assimilate*/ ассимилировать
- To absorb into the cultural tradition of a larger population.
- *Asylum*/ убежище
- Legal permission to live in a country granted in special cases to people fleeing danger or persecution in the homelands.
- *Deport*/ высылать
- To force someone out of the country.
- *Detainee*/ задержанный
- An alien in the custody of the government temporarily.
- *Emigrate*/ эмигрировать
- To leave one's country to live elsewhere.
 - *Émigré*
- A person forced to emigrate for political reasons.

- *Ethnic group/ Этническая группа*

- Large groups of people classed according to common racial, cultural or national origins.
- *Immigrate / иммигрировать*
- To enter a country for the purpose of living there.

- *Nativism/ нейтивистское движение*

- A policy of favoring those born in America over immigrants
- Naturalization/ натурализация
- The process whereby an immigrant becomes a citizen.
